



Import the DoD Certificate into your IE Browser

This document will guide you through uninstalling the incorrect DoD Certificate and installing the correct DoD Certificate into your Internet Explorer Browser.


1. Click on this link <http://dodpki.c3pki.chamb.disa.mil/dodcacerts.cac> and select **Save**.



2. In the **Save As** window, use the down arrow in the **Save In:** drop down list and select **Desktop**. Then click **Save**.



3. If necessary, in the **Download Complete** window, click **Close**.



4. Open an **Internet Explorer Browser** Window and go to **Tools, Internet Options**.






5. In the **Internet Options** window select the **Content Tab**.




6. On the **Internet Options Content** screen, click on the **Certificates...** button.




7. In the **Certificates** window, click the **Import...** button.




8. In the **Welcome to the Certificate Import Wizard** screen, click **Next >**.




9. In the **Certificate Import Wizard** window, click the **Browse...** button.




10. In the **Open** window, use the down arrow in the **Files of type:** drop down list and select **All Files (*.*)**.




11. Once you have selected **All Files (*.*)**, click on the file named **dodcacerts.cer** and then click **Open**.




12. In the **Certificate Import Wizard** window click **Next >**.



13. In the **Certificate Import Wizard** window, select **Automatically select the certificate store based on the type of certificate** and then click **Next >**.




14. In the **Completing the Certificate Import Wizard** window, click **Finish**.




15. In the **Certificate Import Window**, click **OK**.
